HOW TO USE THESE NUMBERS

Here's how to works:

- 1. Count your drips per minute
- 2. Refer to the Dripulator Chart to calculate the gallons of leaked oil per month
- 3. We allowed a little "upward buffer" in the calculations to allow for a leak increasing in speed
- 4. NOTE: The number of feet of Husky PolyBack equals the number of drops per minute.

 There is just one exception. We recommend you cut a minimum of a 2-foot length, even if you only have one drip per minute.

HELPFUL HINT:

Sloping surfaces beneath leaks cause the rain to lift the carry oil downhill. You will notice this based on the diameter of the oily "rain stain" on the concrete or stone. To be safe, cut your section of Husky PolyBack large enough to cover the old stained area.
